

Regional Police Department Feasibility Study Committee  
for Bath, Lisbon and Lyman, New Hampshire

Background Information

During the Lyman Town Meeting on March 14, 2023, the voters approved the following Warrant Article:

Article 14. To see if the Town of Lyman should conduct, with surrounding towns, a feasibility study with interested towns for a Regional Police Department. Each Town will provide a Board member or their designee and other members by Board appointment to conduct monthly meeting(s). No monies to be expended and results of study to be available by March 2024. (Majority vote required)

Similar Warrant Articles were presented at the town meetings in Bath, Landaff, Lisbon and Monroe. Voters in Bath and Lisbon voted to participate in the feasibility study. The Article was not adopted by voters in Landaff and Monroe.

A Regional Police Department Feasibility Study Committee for Bath, Lisbon and Lyman, New Hampshire was established on June 22, 2023. The three participating towns are represented as follows:
